1. Welcome and Introductions: Funding Review training meeting to review ESG rules and considerations

2. Applicant Overview

A. ICCF had requested 20 households of the rapid re-housing and 20 households of prevention obtaining.

B. GRUL requested 10 obtaining households and 9 households prevention retaining.

3. Review funding options

Prevention 36 households, rapid re-housing 37 households. Prevention was split between retaining housing at 17 and obtaining at 19

4. Determine amounts

There had been a number that was incorrect on the document provided to agencies when they applied and a recalculation to split the funding was necessary. The committee agreed that ICCF should have the Rapid Re-housing and share some prevention obtaining, with the exact amounts to be worked out but the remainder of funds. GRUL should take all of the prevention retaining referrals.

5. **MOTION** by Laurie Craft to recommend to Steering Council that The Salvation Army be recertified as the HARA and ICCF and GRUL as agencies to do the rapid rehousing and prevention work for City of Grand Rapids ESG funding in fiscal year 2016, seconded by Rebecca Rynbrandt, all in favor, motion passed
