Task Group A Update Christina Soulard

Discussion

The group worked through what type of agreement we should develop for the providers interacting with Coordinated Assessment (CA) and what they should include. Updates were made to the language related to when the agreement would be terminated, and how to best link to service standards. Further changes were suggested.

Discussion

This group put together a workflow to help providers understand how to receive and accept referrals via HMIS. Five highly used "declined" reasons were called out with further description given. It would be a good thing for the Data Quality Committee to look at and figure out the best form of management for this data.
