Thank you for submitting your renewal application for the Permanent Supportive Housing Expansion project, LOFT2, in the 2019 Continuum of Care Program Application process.

This project's score was 81.8 while the community's median score was 73.6. The Funding Review Committee made the decision to approve more than one request for the Bonus Funding in this round and weighted awards based on the projects' scores.

This project is recommended to be in Tier 2 of the Project Priority Listing when submitted to the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) funded at approximately 80% of the original request of \$306,593 for a total of \$245,593.
