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At the November YAB meeting, YAB discussed the ideal structure moving forward. YAB members had discussed holding their own meetings, instead of meetings run by professionals. There would be assistance from staff and a facilitator with agenda setting for alignment with CoC and Youth Committee goals. Max expressed that members feel that they have an understanding of their roles and are able to take on this additional responsibility. From Brianna's perspective voiced at the YAB meeting, there could be professional development built into the YAB experience allowing for members to potentially become facilitators after they are over the age of 24 and no longer eligible to serve as a YAB member. Julie noted that this change reflects a shift in language around self-governance as members are growing into their roles and YAB is transitioning with them.

YAB is still in the process of recruiting new members. If you know of interested youth, please tell them to connect with YAB members. Brianne can make the connection to YAB members.

Discussion

This ties into the previous conversation. Kendra has been researching youth action boards across the country. In research, she found mentorship roles from those with lived experience are common. Many YABs across the country tackle specific projects and in doing so, learn to self-govern. Professionals provide support and structure to these projects but let YAB members lead. Facilitators then advocate for support from Youth Committee, something that would be helpful for this Youth Committee. Casey noted that professional development is a great idea as many members on the board may be serving on a board for the first time. It was suggested that the vice chair could also work to support recruitment of potential new action board members.

Casey moved to support the proposed updates to position description for leadership. Lauren seconded. All in favor by acclamation with no dissent.

Courtney noted that support may tie into additional funding for the action board. Stipends are only available for only action board meetings, perhaps Youth Committee can help identify funding sources to bridge the gap in funding. This change occurred due to limited planning grant dollars that must fall under allowable expenses from the HUD Planning Grant. Currently, action board funds are limited to action board meetings. Max expressed that additional funding may encourage other YAB members to attend committee meetings.

Julie wondered if it would be helpful to develop the cost of a full functioning youth action board and then show how much can be funded by HUD. Then, Steering Council could recommend how to bring additional funds into the community. YAB can develop an ideal budget for the year with facilitation help from the vice chair.
