Emergency Transfer Plan

Discussion

The Violence Against Women Act (VAWA) requires CoCs have an Emergency Transfer Plan in place for survivors of domestic violence who need to transfer to a new residence. Brianne overviewed the applicability and eligibility criteria of the Emergency Transfer Plan, as well as confidentiality requirements and process and documentation. A flowchart was presented on how to complete the Emergency Transfer Request Process.

Engaging with Persons with Lived Experience

Discussion

This training addressed how to cultivate meaningful and authentic partnerships with people with lived experience with homelessness. Strategies for engagement, trust building, and collaborating on services were detailed.

CoC Program Competition

Discussion

Courtney noted that local applications are due to the CoC on 8/25. These will go through the Funding Review Process, which was overviewed. Reallocation was discussed, and community feedback will be requested via a survey to determine where those funds will be reallocated. Staff recommends the community increase HMIS allocation, as the current amount does not fully support staff, training, overhead costs for staff, and HMIS licenses.

Youth Homelessness Demonstration Program Update

Discussion

Justin Brownlee has been hired as the Youth Homelessness Coordinator at the CoC and will be heavily involved in the YHDP CCP implementation. The YHDP grant agreement is being finalized, and it is anticipated that projects will be starting in the next few months. The community and CoC partners will be updated on start dates and a kickoff meeting as details become available.

Coordinated Entry Infrastructure Update

Discussion

CHC 1.0 will be utilized for all subpopulations soon, with a tentative date of September 15. CHC 2.0 is still being developed, and members of the CoC are encouraged to sign up for consensus building workshops.

Community Partner Announcements and Updates
