#### Discussion

This committee reviewed draft LSA data, due January 9. Courtney noted longer lengths of time homeless across TH and PSH projects and recommended this community prioritize strategizing around these numbers as they will affect the points in CoC Program Competition. It was also noted that YHDP programs and the complex care project may be affecting these numbers. Further analysis is needed to understand shelter numbers versus TH numbers and their effect on length of time homeless. Challenges with obtaining vital documents, completing paperwork, communication, and background checks were cited for PSH population and there was discussion around ways in which the 100 in 100 initiative has worked to reduce these barriers, including more persistent case management.

A question was raised around some demographic data and Alyssa will submit an AAQ for more information.
